The financial report for the period from June 1, 2014 through July 31, 2014 was discussed. Joseph Kitchen moved to approve the financial report as mailed, seconded by Carol Bertrand. Motion passed.

Under the SERC Report, Russ reminded everyone of the upcoming annual Ohio LEPC Conference hosted by the SERC on Friday, September 5, 2014 at the Ohio Fire Academy. Currently Russ Decker, Jim Michael and Dieter Wireman have expressed an interest in attending. Rick Skilliter offered a motion to approve up to \$500 for expense reimbursement for those members attending the conference, seconded by Ted Brookman. Motion passed. Russ also announced that the 2014 SERC grant award has been received in the amount of \$29,821.00 and will be reflected in the next financial report as it was received after July 31, 2014.

Under the Emergency Coordinator's Report, Russ reported on 90 calls for service since the last meeting with 16 of those involving hazardous materials. Year-to-date, the EMA has handled 348 calls for service with 65 of those involving hazardous materials.

Under Committee Reports, the Enforcement Committee announced that it would be issuing a Notice of Violation against Pepsi for a delay in reporting a recent ammonia

release at their facility. The EMA is currently conducting facility compliance visits at 16 EHS sites.

Being no further business to come before the Committee, Bill Kelly moved to adjourn, seconded by Jeff Ramey. The meeting stood adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
